

Job Postings for Summer Migrant Program 2026

The program will run from June 1 through June 25, 2026 for students – Monday through Thursday with the exception of June 3 and 4 when staff will be attending the Statewide Conference.

The following positions require valid teacher certification. It is highly desirable that teachers are Bi/Tri-lingual in Spanish/English, French/English or Spanish/French/English or have ESL certification. In addition to teaching responsibilities, all hired teachers must attend the pre-service on May 6 from 3:45 - 7:45 pm in Beardstown. Also, all teachers must attend the local in-service May 28 and 29 and the Statewide Migrant Conference on June 3-4, 2026 in Peoria. All Pre-K to 11 teachers must implement learning activities utilizing the literacy and math curriculum as set by the Beardstown Migrant Program and maintain consistent attendance through the summer.

The following positions prefer current classroom aide certification or college hours that have been verified by Beardstown District #15. It is desired that aides are Bi/Tri-lingual in Spanish/English, French/English or Spanish/French/English. In addition to all assisting and language support duties, all hired aides must attend the local in-service May 28 and 29 and the Statewide Migrant Conference on June 3-4, 2026 in Peoria. All Pre-K to 11 aides must support the literacy and math curriculum as set by the Beardstown Migrant Program and maintain consistent attendance throughout the summer. All classroom aides will be expected to support the preparation and the delivery of learning lessons and activities.
