

1. Using or possessing an electronic device and or wearable technology. In accordance with Illinois lawmakers passing [Senate Bill 2427](#), instituting a statewide "bell-to-bell" ban on personal cell phone use during school hours, cell phones are not permitted in school.

Cell Phone disciplinary offenses: 1st Offense The device will be confiscated and returned to the student at the end of the day. 2nd Offense A 60 minute detention will be given and the device will be confiscated. A parent or guardian must pick up the device in the high school office. 3rd Offense A 2 hour detention will be given and the device will be confiscated. A parent or guardian must pick up the device in the high school office. 4th Offense An in-school suspension will be given and the device will be confiscated. A parent or guardian must pick up the device in the high school office. 5th Offense An out of school suspension will be given and the device will be confiscated. A parent or guardian must pick up the device in the high school office and the student will lose this privilege meaning they cannot have a cell phone in the building.
